Why?



- Effort to make the CANS more meaningful in service planning and delivery:
 - Easier to understand and apply to work
 - Creation of progress reports
 - Creation of longitudinal reports
- Federal requirement for DSS assessment
 - CANS will be linked in OASIS to the service plan (2017)
- Current CANVaS site interface can be difficult to use

What's New?




- Look and interface of site
- Local Administrator Role (DSU/RA)
- DSS-Enhanced Version and Standard Version
- Emphasis on use of Item/Rating Definitions Manual



What's New?



- Assessments open longer than 60 days will be deleted (15 day “grace” period)
- Item wording changes
- Child and Permanency Progress Reports
- Longitudinal Specialty Reports



What doesn't change



- Certification process will not change. Users will still complete the training and certification process on www.canstraining.com
- Praed Certification #ID will be matched “behind the scenes” as is now done for recertifications



Transition



- All current data will be converted to new system
 - User accounts including role
 - Assessments
 - Assessments that are “open” as of the transition date will be lost even if within the 60-75 day timeframe.



Current projected transition date will be the weekend of July 1 so site will be unavailable for 3-4 day timeframe.
