# About ID & DS Waivers

- States apply to CMS/Medicaid match
- For individuals with intellectual disability
- Pays for long-term in-home and community services
- Waives certain Federal Medicaid requirements
- Two of 6 Home & Community Based Waivers
  Virginia offers

## **ID Waiver Highlights**

- Began ID Waiver in 1991
- Expanded services in 1994
- Added Consumer-Directed Services in 2001
- Added Day Support Waiver in 2005
- Added MFP in 2008
- Added PC Practices and the SIS in 2009

## Community Services Boards (CSBs) **or** Behavioral Health Authority (BHAs)

- Single point of entry
- Support Coordination

- Selected by the individual
- Person-centered supports

- Technical Assistance

## Department of Medical Assistance Services (DMAS)

- Single state agency for Medicaid
- Payment to providers
- Service audits
- Appeals

## **Diagnostic Eligibility**

#### 6 years or older:

psychological evaluation stating diagnosis of intellectual disability

#### Under age 6:

psychological or standardized developmental evaluation stating diagnosis of intellectual disability or "at developmental risk" **Functional Eligibility** 

# CSB Support Coordinator (SC) confirms functional eligibility by completing:

Level Of Functioning (LOF) Survey

Within 45 days of date of request for services

# **Financial Eligibility**



- DSS-determined
- Different financial limits for Medicaid Waivers
- Based upon the individual's income only
- Possible patient-pay obligation

# If Waiver diagnostic, functional and financial eligibility determined, the CSB



 Awards an individual a slot, if available

OR

Places name on the wait list

# Waiver Slots

- ID slots are awarded based upon level of needs/urgency
- DS slots are awarded based upon length of time on the wait list

## Annual ID allocations

Slot re-assignments





If no slot, name placed on a Statewide Waiting List (WL)

- CSB submits to DBHDS
  - Urgent and Non-urgent
- DBHDS maintains Statewide WL
- All Urgent in state served first



- 3) Day Support Services
- 4) Prevocational Services

# **DSP** Orientation Manual

## **Supervisors of DSPs**:

- Complete the DSP Orientation online training
- Pass the online DSP Orientation Test to obtain a certificate
- Complete the Supervisor Assurance

DSPs must:

- Review orientation materials with supervisor
- Complete orientation test with 80% accuracy
- Sign "DSP Assurance" with supervisor

# All Waiver providers must have a DMAS Participation Agreement



## <u>May not</u> be parents of individuals under 18 **or** the individual's spouse





Can be other family members living under the same roof

#### <u>IF</u>



Must have <u>same qualifications</u> as other agency staff




