What is Continuous Quality Improvement?

Reviewing data to make plans and decisions that improve programs and outcomes

"A framework for getting from talk to action quickly and making a difference, not just trying hard and hoping for the best."

Ask three key questions:

- How much did we do?
- How well did we do it?
- Is anyone better off?



In all 130 localities, at least half of the CSA youth received only community-based services; in 115, the proportion was at least 75 percent. Seven localities reported that 100 percent of youth received only community-based services (no residential services received).





 – CPMT responses to a full survey (SurveyMonkey) on odd years and a follow-up survey on even years (2025= full survey will be sent)

What questions can these data help answer?

- How does my program's experience align with or differ from what was reported by other localities and statewide?
- Where are collaborative opportunities? Among localities that have addressed barriers, or have similar service needs?





CQI dashboard data consist of information submitted by individual Virginia localities for youth receiving CSA-funded services in the reporting period.






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













How Well is it Done? Virginia DSS Foster Care Outcomes

• What % of youth in care are in non-residential placements?






