

enhancing awareness:


- community connections

Maximizing the Role of the Parent Representative on FAPTs Activities

WITH YOUTH / FAMILY

- Call the day before / morning of
 - Discuss expectations of the process & the youth/family's responsibilities
- Meet in the lobby / escort in
- Wait for them to be seated first
 - Respect & value their
 position as the expert on their family
- Call afterward as a check-in
- Conduct the family survey



WITH FAPT MEMBERS

- Introduce self & share story
- Attend retreats / events
 - Team Building
- Use Name Tents for Identification
 - Everyone knows the youth/family - they deserve to know the Team
- Review policies, procedures, brochures, etc., for familyfriendly language



TAKEAWAYS

FOR PARENT REPS:

Being consistent with communication, attending meetings (FAPT & otherwise), displaying vulnerability and courage through sharing your story, modeling strengthbased language, etc., will build trust with the FAPT members.



Investing in the relationship with the **Parent Representative will** empower them to feel part of the Team and in turn, they will feel empowered to support the youth/family with trusting the process and staying engaged.


