Coordinated Specialty Care for First Episode Psychosis is:

- ► An evidence-based, individual-centered, recovery-oriented mental health service delivery model.
- ► Facilitates community living, psychosocial rehabilitation and recovery for persons who have experienced a first episode of psychosis.

► Collaborative, multidisciplinary team treatment approach.



Features of CSC:

- ► The team is mobile and can deliver services in a non-traditional or community location
- ► Treatment duration of 2 to 5 years
- ➤ "Relentless Engagement"
- ► Recovery-based philosophy of care



Admission Criteria:

▶ Diagnosis of a psychotic disorder with the duration of untreated psychosis within 2 years

► Ages 15-30

► Can have co-occurring diagnosis of SUD if substance abuse is not determining factor of their psychosis.
